COVID-19 vaccine Medicare





Everyone in Australia can get a free COVID-19 vaccination (any visa type and no Medicare is required).



If you **don't have** a Medicare card, you can get the vaccine at any hospital, government vaccination centre and some GP respiratory clinics.



Check the **Queensland Health website** to find out where you can get the vaccine.



After you get the vaccine, you can ask the vaccination provider to **print out your immunisation record for you.**



You can also call the Australian Immunisation Register on **1800 653 809** and ask for a copy of your immunisation record. No Medicare is needed, but you will need to provide some personal details like your name and address.

- Call 134 COVID **(that is call 13 42 68)** if you have any questions about the vaccine program. You can call 24 hours, every day. Ask for an interpreter if you need one.
- Or, call the Translating and Interpreting Service on 13 14 50 who can connect you to any national health service.
