



Queensland agribusiness continuity planning

Further COVID-19 cases are likely in Queensland as we open up. Vaccination is key to protect your agribusinesses and supply chains from COVID-19. Encourage your workers to be fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated means a person has received the prescribed number of doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, and it has been two weeks since the final dose.

COVID-19 presents a risk to your agribusiness operation, staff and supply chains. Now is the time to plan how your operations will continue should a COVID-19 outbreak occur in your community or business.

- ✓ Use the COVID safe checklist
- ✓ Adopt a work health safety plan for COVID-19
- ✓ Keep records that demonstrate adherence to your plan
- ✓ Use the Check In Qld app for contact tracing
- ✓ Get tested immediately if you have COVID-19 symptoms and isolate until you get a negative result.
