



Information for Queensland agribusinesses: COVID-19 vaccinations, testing and public health and social measures

Vaccinations

By adopting COVID-19 safe measures, agribusinesses will minimise the impact of COVID-19 on their employees, business, and community. It is important that the Queensland community prioritise COVID-19 [vaccinations](#) including [booster vaccinations](#). Information about [when and where](#) to get your vaccination booster(s) is now available.

COVID-19 testing

You can [find your nearest COVID-19 testing centre](#) by regularly viewing the [map](#), or contacting your [local hospital](#), or by calling 134 COVID (134 268).

Polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests are the most reliable and accurate tests available in Australia for detecting positive COVID-19 infection. Other types of tests, such as rapid antigen tests, are available commercially for your own use.

Public health and social measures

In Queensland, [face masks](#) must be worn in some settings.

There are quarantine and testing requirements for [close contacts](#). There are [isolation](#) requirements for confirmed COVID-19 cases.
