Innovation and investment in Queensland agriculture

Peter Kenny Medal criteria

Nominations must meet at least one of the following categories, in addition to the general criteria:

1. Professional contribution

The nominee demonstrates professional excellence and leadership in the development and/or delivery of an innovative agricultural product, service or technology that makes an outstanding contribution to the profitability and sustainability of the agriculture, fisheries and forestry sector.

2. Industry and community contribution

The nominee makes an outstanding contribution to advancing industry objectives and supporting rural and regional communities through initiatives such as advocacy, education, promoting social cohesion, collaboration, profitability and sustainability.

General criteria

For each category, nominations must detail how the nominee demonstrates the following:

- Qualities commonly associated with leadership including, but not limited to, innovation, creativity, positive influence on others, strong communication skills and ethical conduct.
- An outstanding contribution beyond the scope of their position or role, by taking on challenges and going 'above and beyond' the demands of their day-to-day responsibilities.
- Development or delivery of a product, service or technology that has a point of difference, unique value proposition to industry, demonstrates innovation and/or a creative approach to addressing an existing or emerging problem in the agriculture, fisheries and/or forestry sector.

Award eligibility

To be eligible for a nomination, an individual must:

- be 18 years or older
- be an Australian citizen and a Queensland resident
- have made a significant and outstanding contribution to the agriculture, fisheries and/or forestry sector in terms of leadership and innovation leading to profitability and sustainability.

Applicants may apply from any agricultural fisheries or forestry field, including but not limited to, agribusiness, education, farm-based production, supply chain operations, research or policy.

It must include personal contact details and answers to these two questions.

- Please provide a supporting statement that describes the nominee's leadership and innovation leading to profitability and sustainability, and how these qualities have been demonstrated.
- What other information might support the nominee's suitability for the Peter Kenny Medal?
